

PROPOSED CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAW CHANGES – January 2022

ARTICLE 10

AMENDMENTS

Section 1. Proposed Amendments

This Constitution and By-Laws may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote (except for changes in dues and assessments, and initiation and reinstatement fees, which shall require a majority vote, as provided in Article 8, Sections 3 and 4) at a regular meeting, provided that each member in good standing is notified in writing of the proposed amendment at least fifteen (15) days in advance of the meeting at which the vote will be taken.

Section 2. Adopted Amendments

A proposed amendment to this Constitution and By-Laws shall be submitted for approval to the International General President after it has first been adopted by the membership and prior to its printing or issuance.

Proposed Changes Below

ARTICLE 4 – OFFICERS AND ELECTIONS

Section 2. Officers

President– It shall be the duties of the President to attend all meetings of the Local and the board. They will preserve order during deliberations appoint all committees with the approval of the board and shall be a voting, ex-officio member of all committees. Have the power to call special meetings of the committee, and special meetings of this organization, subject to the approval of the board. Make a written and oral report of activities for the year at the annual convention. A copy of this report will be presented to the Secretary and Treasurer. Should any officer fail to perform their respective duty, the President shall request a vote of the board for removal of that officer.

Vice-president-It shall be the duties of the Vice-president to execute all duties of the President if he/she is unable to do so. To ensure equal representation, the Vice-president shall be appointed in alternation from the President from either NDF or National Guard (i.e., if the President is NDF, the Vice-president must be National Guard and vice-versa).

Board - The Executive Board shall consist of the President, Vice-president, Secretary, and Treasurer, and four [4] trustees, who are elected at the biennial meeting. Trustees shall be appointed to provide union representation across represented bodies. One (1) Western Representative, one (1) Northern Representative, one (1) Southern Representative and one (1) Guard Representative will constitute the four (4) trustees. It shall be the duty of the Executive Board to exercise general supervision and control of the invested funds and property of the Local. It shall have the authority to act in the name of the Local during intervals between meetings, such acts being subject to confirmation by the membership at the next regular meeting of the Local. It shall provide for an annual audit of the Treasurer's books. It shall meet at the call of the President or on call signed by a majority of its members. A majority shall constitute a quorum.
